



IMPORTANT NOTICE TO ATLANTIC HORSE RACING PARTICIPANTS

Basic Requirements for Racing in 2019

Atlantic Provinces Harness Racing Commission (APHRC) & Standardbred Canada (SC)

What is Required?	Penalty	SC Field Representative	Who Decides	What you Must Do
A valid licence with both APHRC and SC	If you have an invalid or expired licence you will not be permitted to race.	Each race day a report on invalid/expired licences is provided to Senior Judge	Senior Judge	Renew licence – Complete renewal form and pay applicable fees to SC Field Representative or , fax signed and completed renewal form and payment into SC head office or , pay SC online www.standardbredcanada.ca using your assigned Eshop number.
No outstanding Fines or Suspensions	If you have an outstanding fine or are under suspension, you will not be permitted to race	Each race day a report, on up-to-date information from all tracks on outstanding fines and suspensions, is provided to Senior Judge	Senior Judge	In the case of a fine, you must pay any outstanding amount to SC Field Representative.
2019 Eligibility Fees	If an eligibility fee is not paid the horse may start once, in a qualifier or race , but will be suspended until payment is made. <i>Note: payment is required even if the horse only has one start, in a qualifier or race, in the given year.</i>	Each race day a report is provided to Senior Judge on unpaid eligibility fees.	Senior Judge	Pay to SC Field Representative the annual fee of \$73.00 for the respective horse OR , pay, SC online www.standardbredcanada.ca using your assigned Eshop number.
Valid negative Coggins Test within 24 months	Horse with invalid Coggins Test will be permitted one start only	Each race day a report, on horses with expired Coggins Test, is provided to Senior Judge	Senior Judge	Provide SC Field Representative with proof of a valid negative Coggins Test.
Parentage Verification	Any horse not parentage verified will not be permitted to race	After the draw, SC head office will notify of horses not P.V.'d. List will be provided to Judges	Senior Judge	Contact SC by telephone, fax or e-mail for the appropriate DNA forms to complete parentage verification
Freeze Branding or Microchip	Any horse not properly identified by freeze brand or microchip will not be permitted to race.	After the draw, a list of horses not freeze branded or microchip will be provided to Senior Judge who notifies person responsible for horse	Senior Judge	Arrange to have horse identified by SC Identification Technician
